Visitor Centers

The Park administration operates five "Visitor Centers," which are free and open to the public. These include the following:

EL ACEBUCHE VISITOR CENTER

Access: Located in the province of Huelva, it is accessible from the A-483 Almonte-Matalascañas road at Km. 38.

Visitor Centers

Access: Located in the province of Huelva, it is accessible through the La Rocina Visitor Center, 7 km away via an interior road.

JOSE ANTONIO VALVERDE VISITOR CENTER

Access: Located in the province of Seville, in the Aznalcázar marshes. It can be accessed from Villamanrique de la Condesa, 30 km away, mostly via an unpaved road, from Isla Mayor, 30 km away via an unpaved road, and from Puebla del Río, 60 km away, half on a paved road and half on an unpaved road.

Visitor Centers

Additionally, it is essential to mention that the Doñana National Park is mostly surrounded by the Doñana Natural Park, which was created as a buffer zone to mitigate possible impacts on the National Park and encompasses a series of natural and cultural riches of undeniable value. It is an ideal place for Active Tourism enthusiasts, as the Natural Park offers bike lanes, extensive hiking trails, as well as horseback riding and off-road tours.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Horseback riding routes are available in the Natural Park, and the companies that offer them are:

OFF-ROAD TOURS

To explore other ecosystems, **Coop**. **Marismas del Rocío** offers a guided tour from El Acebuche in an off-road bus with a driver-guide, covering around 70 km along the beach, dunes, forests, and marshlands of the National Park (all ecosystems).

BOAT TOUR Buque Real Fernando River Cruise

Boat tour (30 km): Departure from the Bajo Guía dock in Sanlúcar de Barrameda. This is a 3.5-hour tour along the mouth of the Guadalquivir River, with a 1-hour stop at Doñana National Park, where visitors can explore the old "Plancha" settlement (an old village of huts) and walk a trail to learn about traditional uses and local flora. The journey continues along the river to the "Salinas" (salt flats), a marshland area within the Doñana Natural Park, where you will spend around 30 minutes. There, you will walk a small trail to reach a birdwatching observatory for aquatic birds.
